

A CREATION FOR BABIES

INTENTIONS

This project was born from Danièle Temstet's will to go further and deeper inside research concerning live performance especially dedicated to early childhood.

After Coussin-Couça and Ô Mama Ô, the purpose consists in creating a new show really adapted to babies and planned to be played as well in the intimacy of their usual environment as in theater rooms.

This new and soft experience is expected to develop the baby's sensory attention when put on the outside of his family context. An occasion to **meet and discover live performance** which incites parents to put a different look on their child, and may extract this child from his daily references.

In order to immerse the babies in an emotionnal, fun and stimulating bath, Danièle Temstet and Georges Nounou have created a specially adapted musical and scenographic language which allows them to establish links between words, music, colours and light.

THEME

PLOÙM

The only bird in the world which has got fins... or the initiatic journey of a baby penguin looking for himself...

This new creation approaches the theme of the life to its beginning.

At first with birth, seen from the inside by a new born baby, then with his permanent need to be watched by the others (and especially his mother) to help him to grow.

STORYBOARD

Ploum is a baby penguin, waiting quiet in the warmth of his egg.

But time happens where he has to leave this egg to get birth. He soon discovers the world, but the soft and musicsounding voice which used to cuddle him has vanished: he is quite alone, wondering who he is and where he comes from. The only thing he knows and repeats to himself is: "I've got a mom."

Consequently, Ploum decides to move in order to look for his mom. Walking that way, he meets several animals, each one of them symbolising a new kind of natural environment: the polar Bear for the Ice, the Walrus for the sea, the Albatros for the air... and the Human being for the Earth's fire.

Each time he meets someone, he thinks he has found who he is: he just swims like a fish, his body seems to be covered with feathers, his belly is all white (the same as a polar bear), he uses to stand up like humans do, but no, definitively not!

Really lost and desappointed to have no relative, Ploum continues on his way that leads him back to his starting point.

Ploum, unknowingly, has followed the polar circle... and stands now back in front of his egg!

There, he sees a bird which really looks like him.

His mom, of course.

She had only left awhile, searching around for his first meal.

MUSIC

As usual in any creation by the Theatre en Flammes, music is essential.

The compositions are original, written by Georges Nounou and totally played live.

There are different types of interventions: songs, sound effects, atmospheric or rythmic accompaniment.

Music completes the different kinds of language used in *Ploum*: nursery rhymes, onomatopoeias, fingerplays or videoprojection.

The instrumentation is essentially based on a soft keyboard, sounding like a pipe organ, but also on percussions and flute.

A engaging sound universe, both soft and rythmic, conceived to provide a first musical emotion.

SCENOGRAPHIC CONCEPT

The scenographic project of this show presents all style characteristics included in Danièle Temstet and Georges Nounou's works in their research on live performance adapted to early childhood.

According to the principle of breaking the barrier between actors and spectators in the context of a baby-show, Ploùm's scenographic creation will consist in a stylised igloo inside of which sits a giant egg, central piece of the dramatization, light source and projection screen all in one.

Built in PVC tubes and covered with a large piece of translucent white tissue, the igloo will appear in fact as its own silhouette. The tubes will cross as meridians and parrallels of a terrestrial globe, and the last parrallel will represent the arctic polar circle, put on there as the red thread of the story.

This blue-white scenery will be cut by bright and primary color objects, as some kind of accidents in a quiet uniform color space.


The children will be installed with the actors in the igloo to take part (with Ploùm) to an adventure all in softness and sensory emotions.

CO-PRODUCTION

This show has been created in partnership with the festival **Au Bonheur des Mômes** (Le Grand-Bornand / France). 20 representations have been programmed between 24 and 28 August 2009.

After the successfull *Ô Mama Ô* representations at the festival **Au Bonheur des Mômes** (2007), the artistic direction of Le Grand-Bornand decided to co-produce the brand new creation of the Théâtre en Flammes, **Ploùm**, "a baby show in an igloo" (2009).


